So Abraham's servant made the promise and got ready to leave.

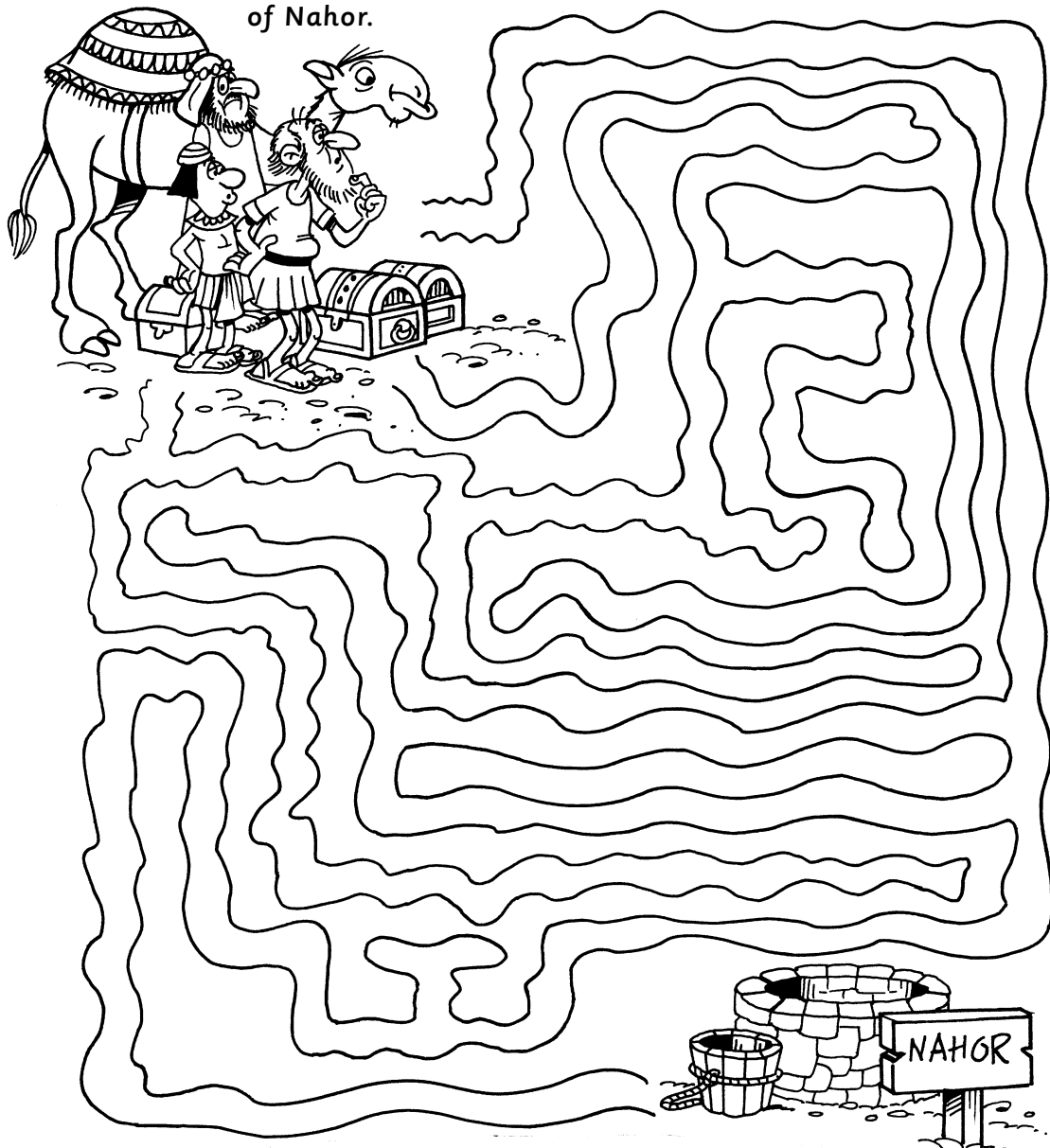

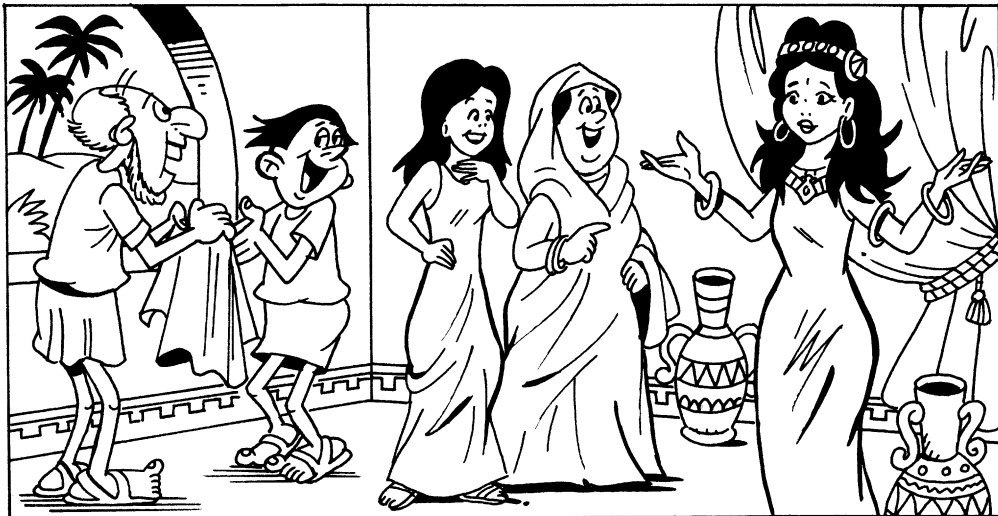
