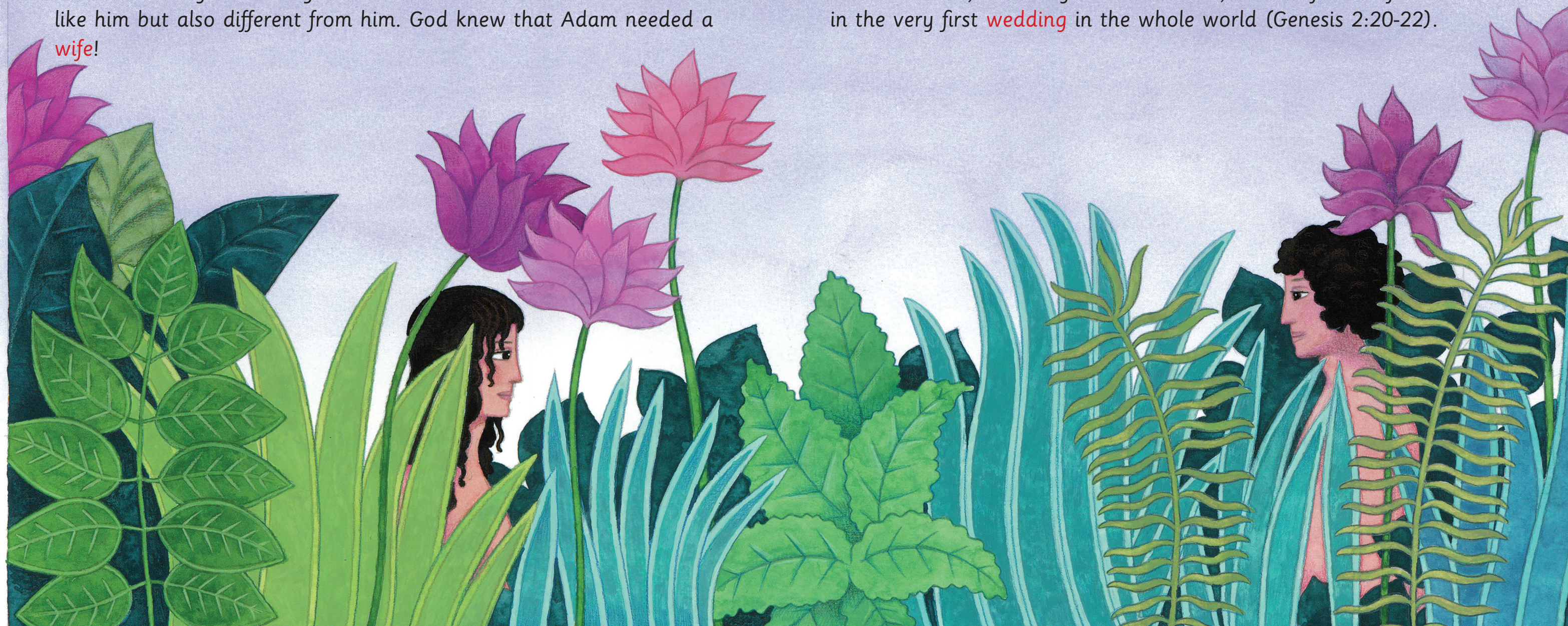

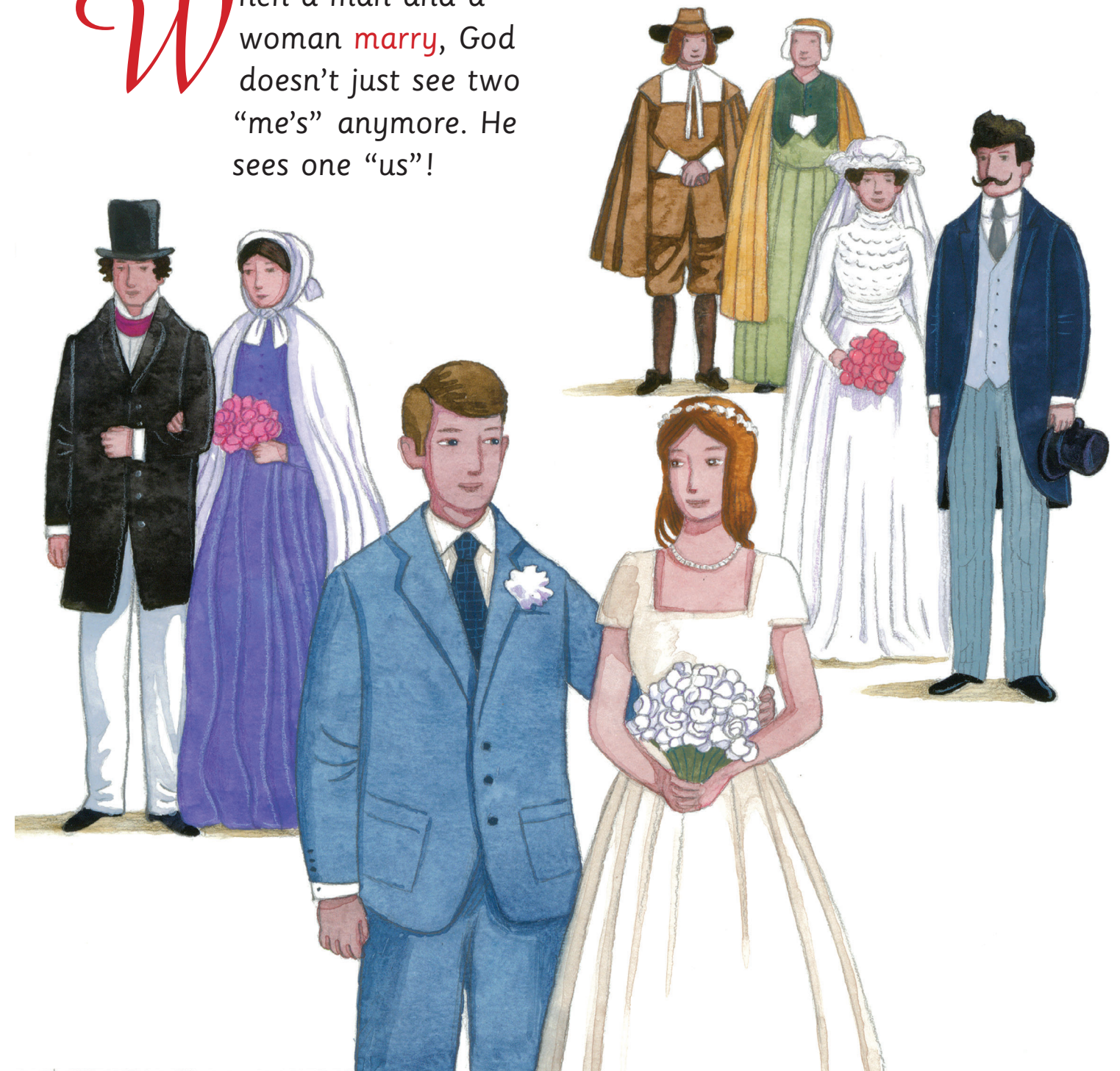


Ever since that first **wedding**, people have been getting **married**. Just like everything that comes from the heart of God, **marriage** is beautiful and good.

Jesus says that when a man and woman get **married**, God joins them together in the most special of all relationships here on earth. God looks at the two of them as one, and no one should ever separate them (Matthew 19:6).
