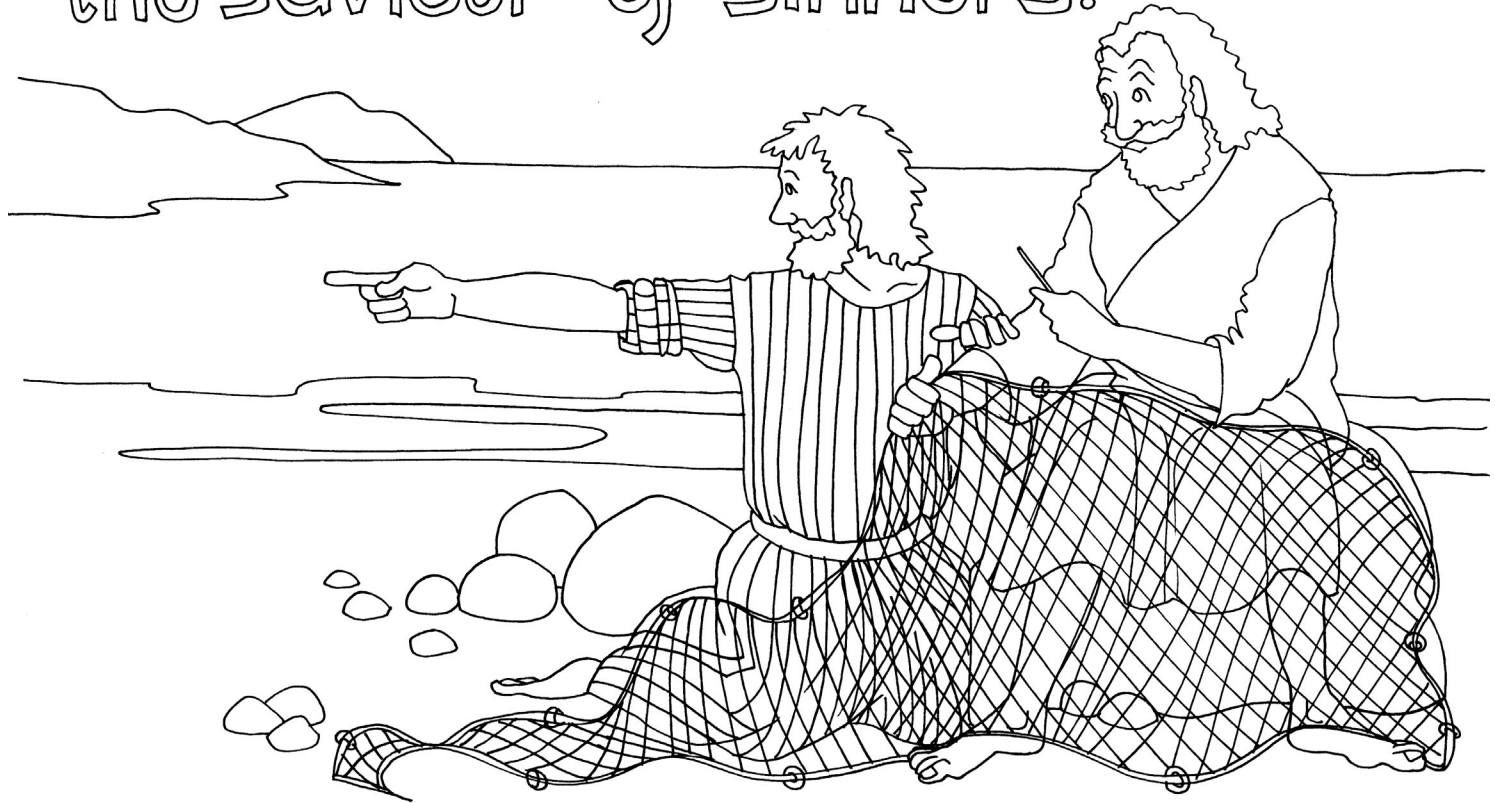


Peter and his brother Andrew

the saviour of sinners.

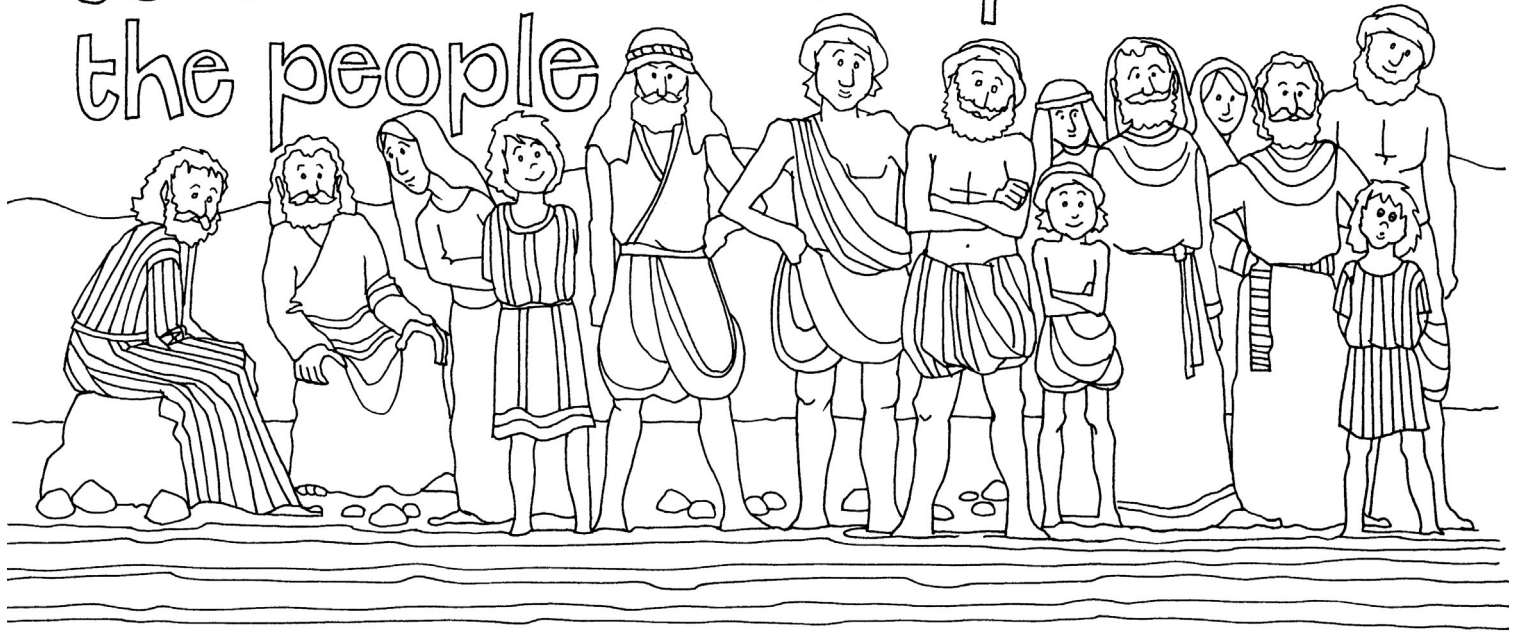




One night

but caught nothing.

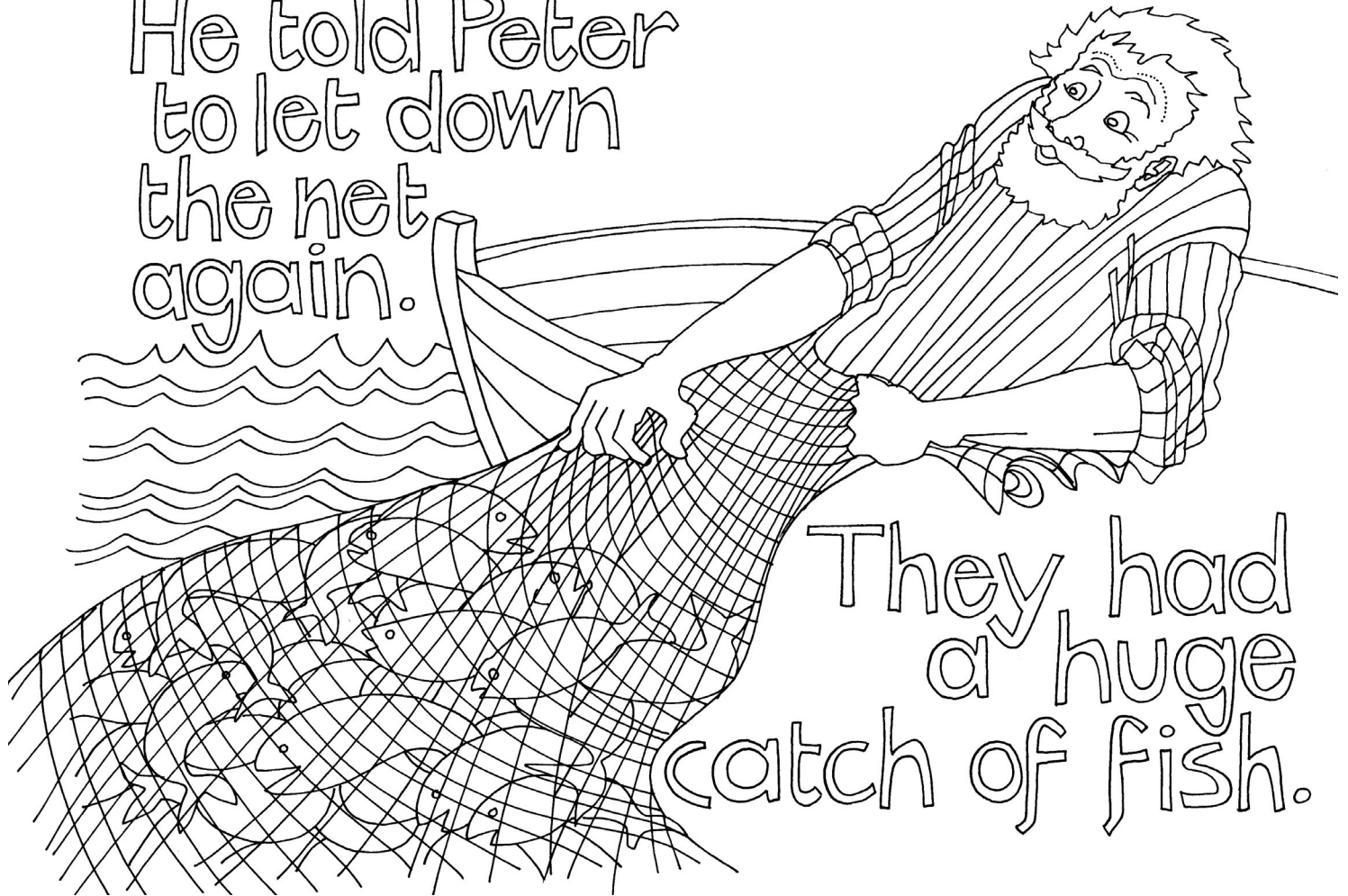


Jesus wanted to speak to

again.

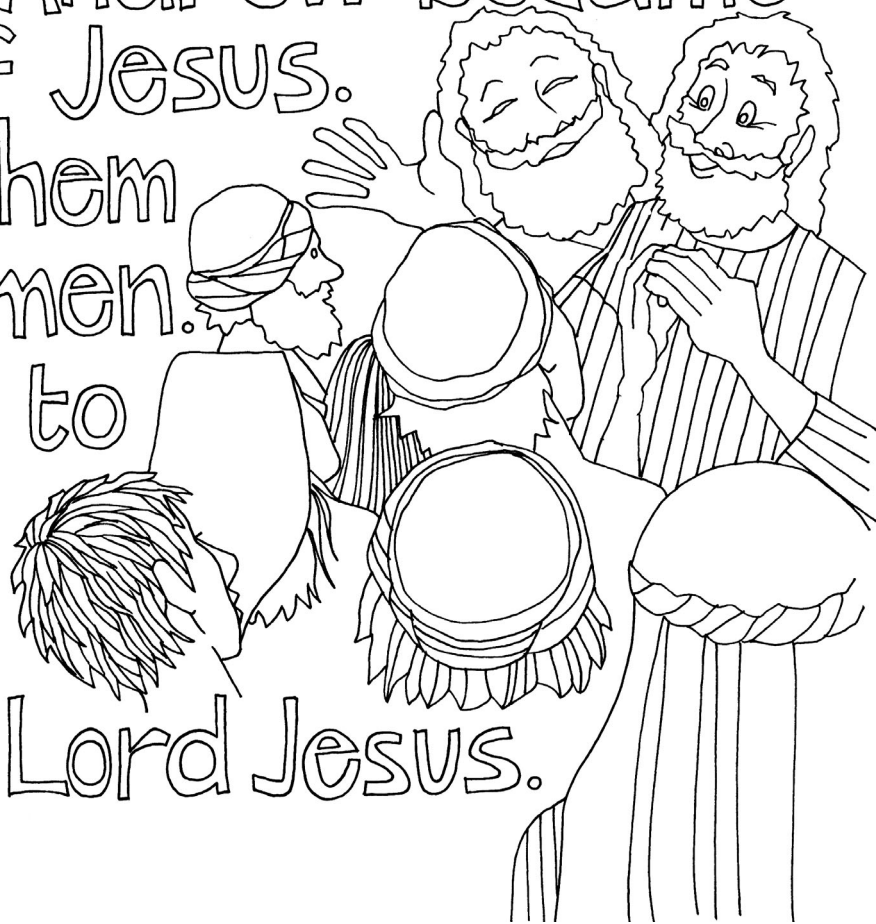


They had

catch of fish.

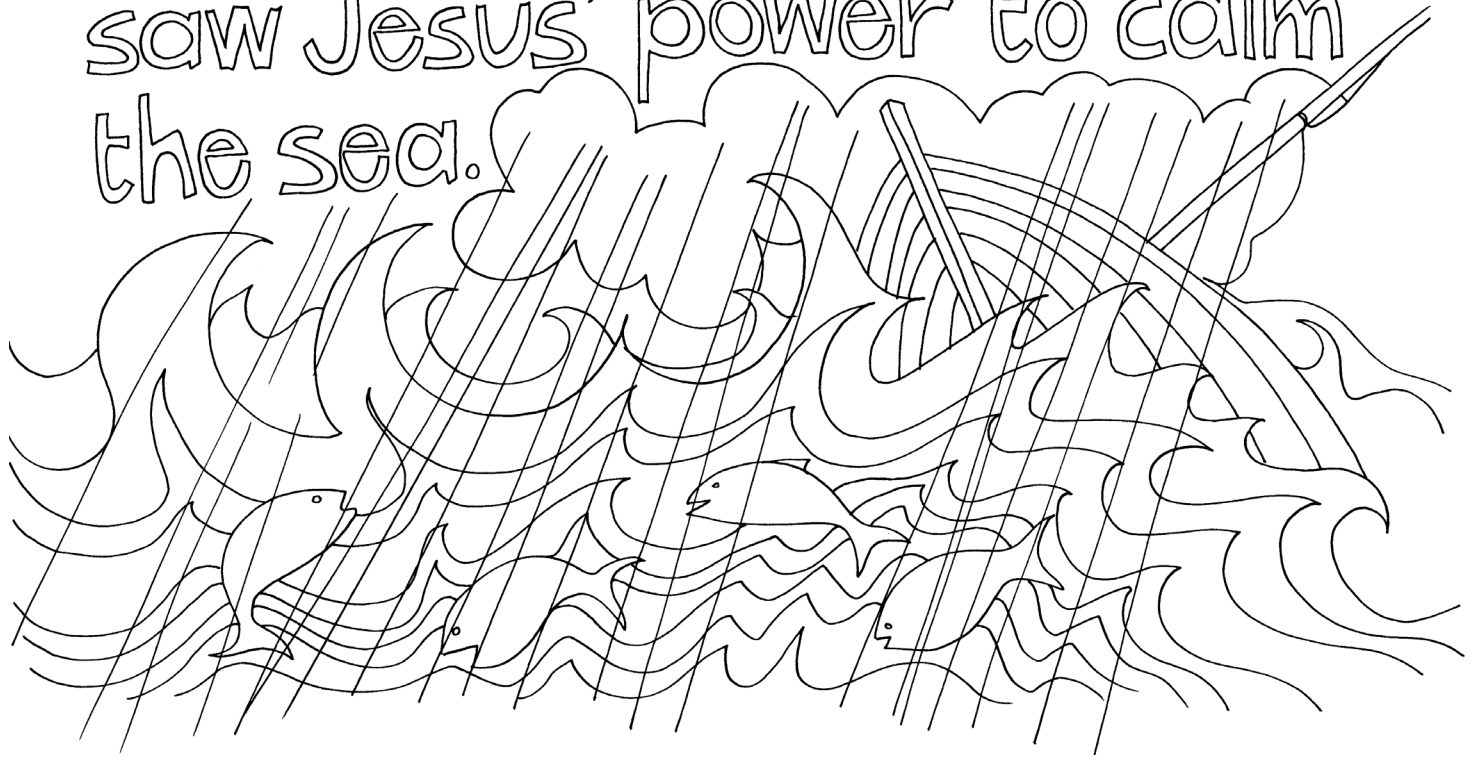
Peter and Andrew became

wonderful Lord Jesus.

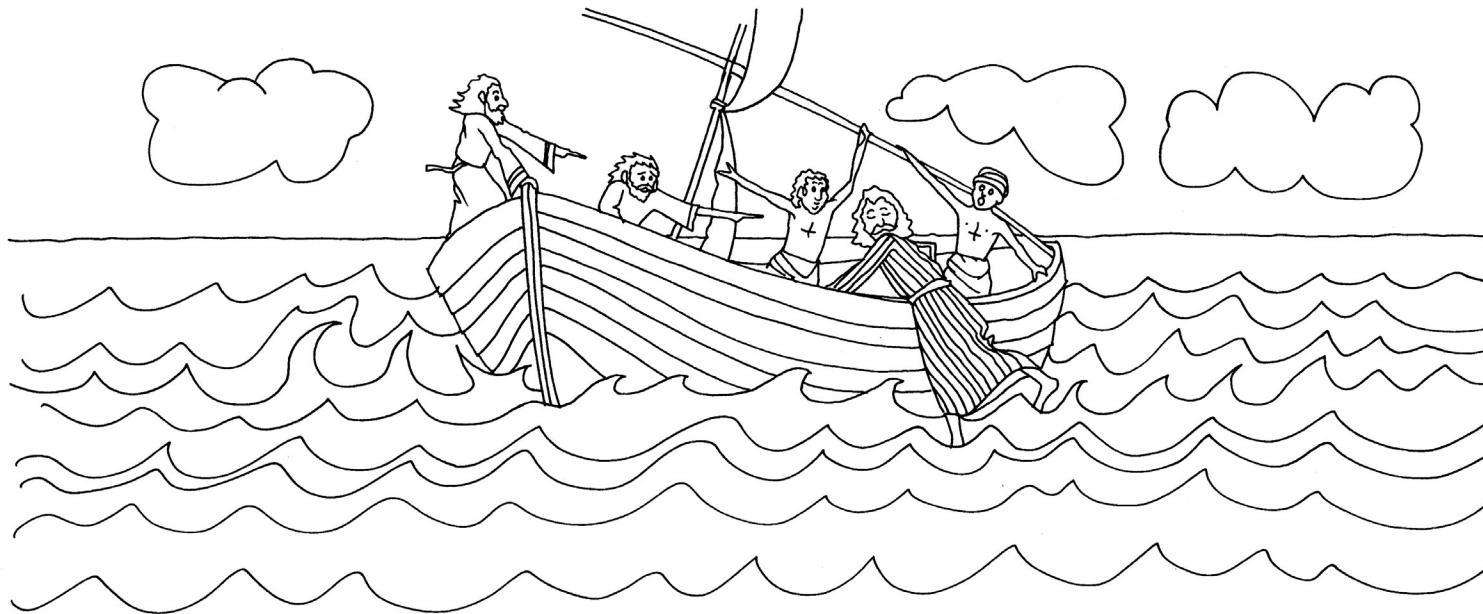


Once there was

knew Jesus.

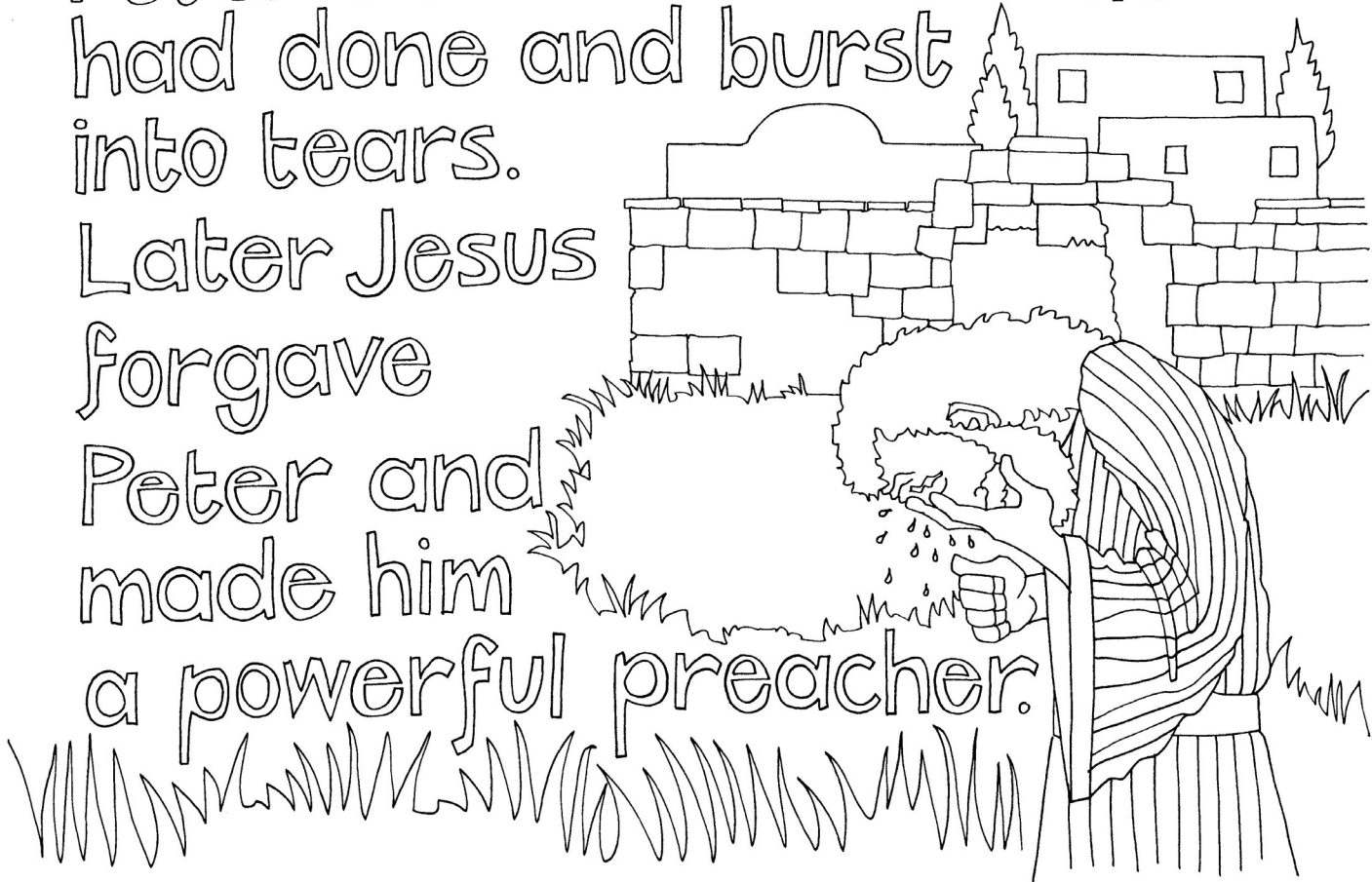




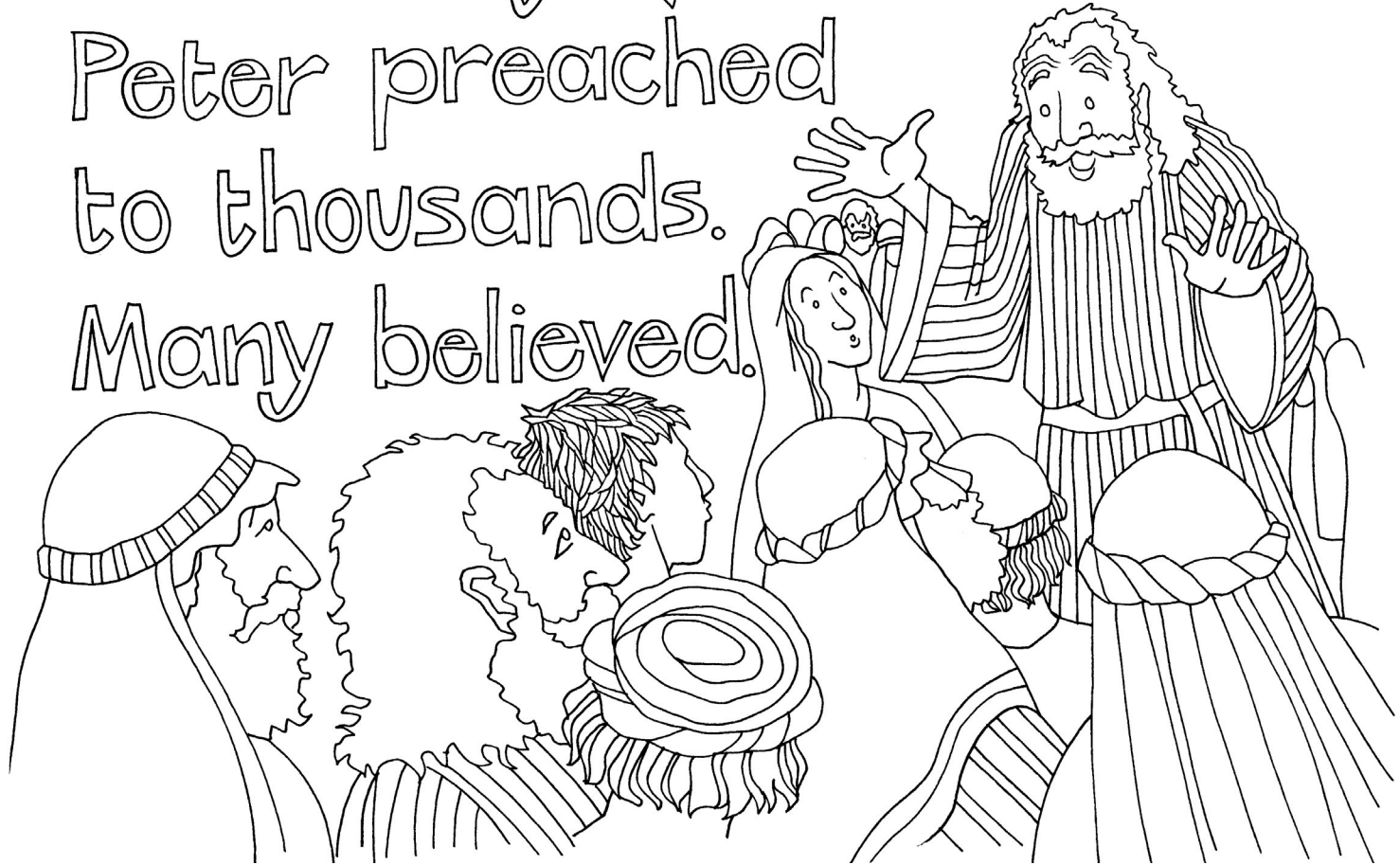
Peter realized what he

a powerful preacher.

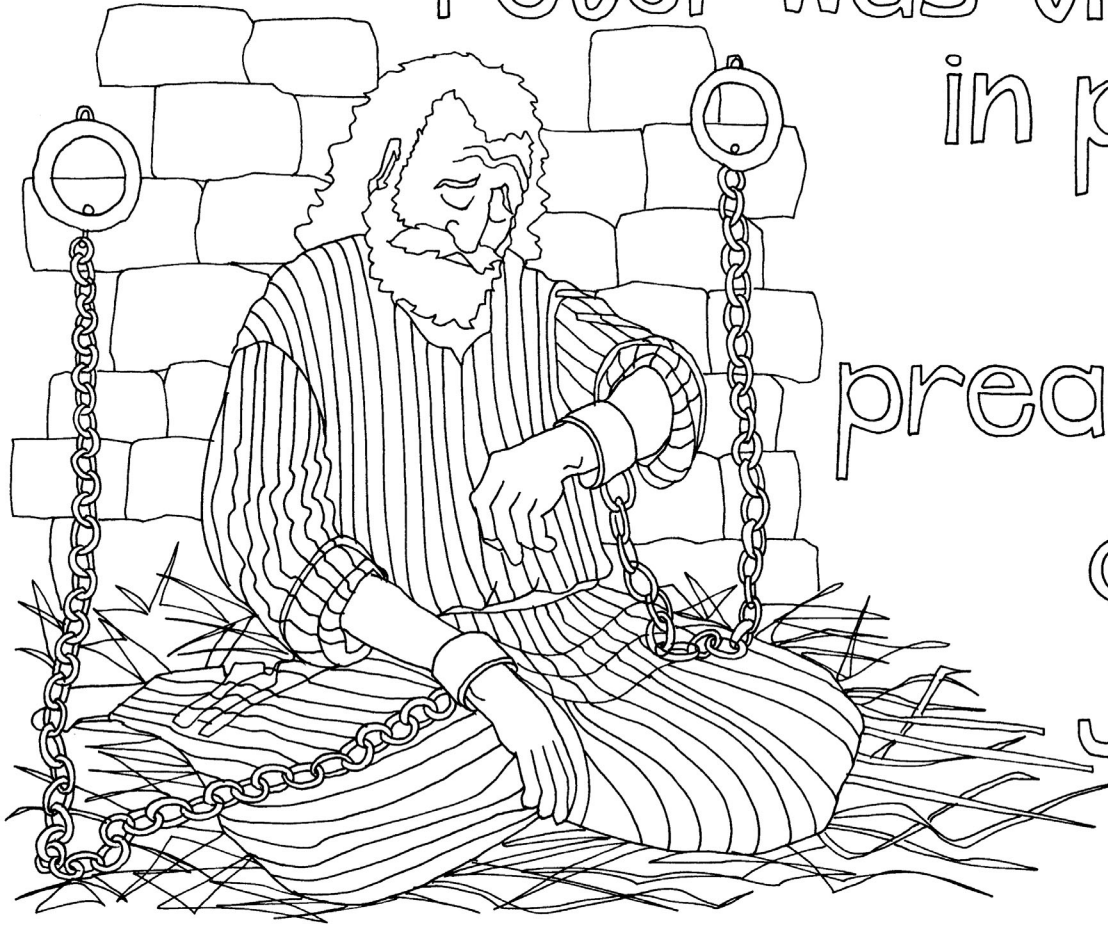


On the day of Pentecost

Many believed.

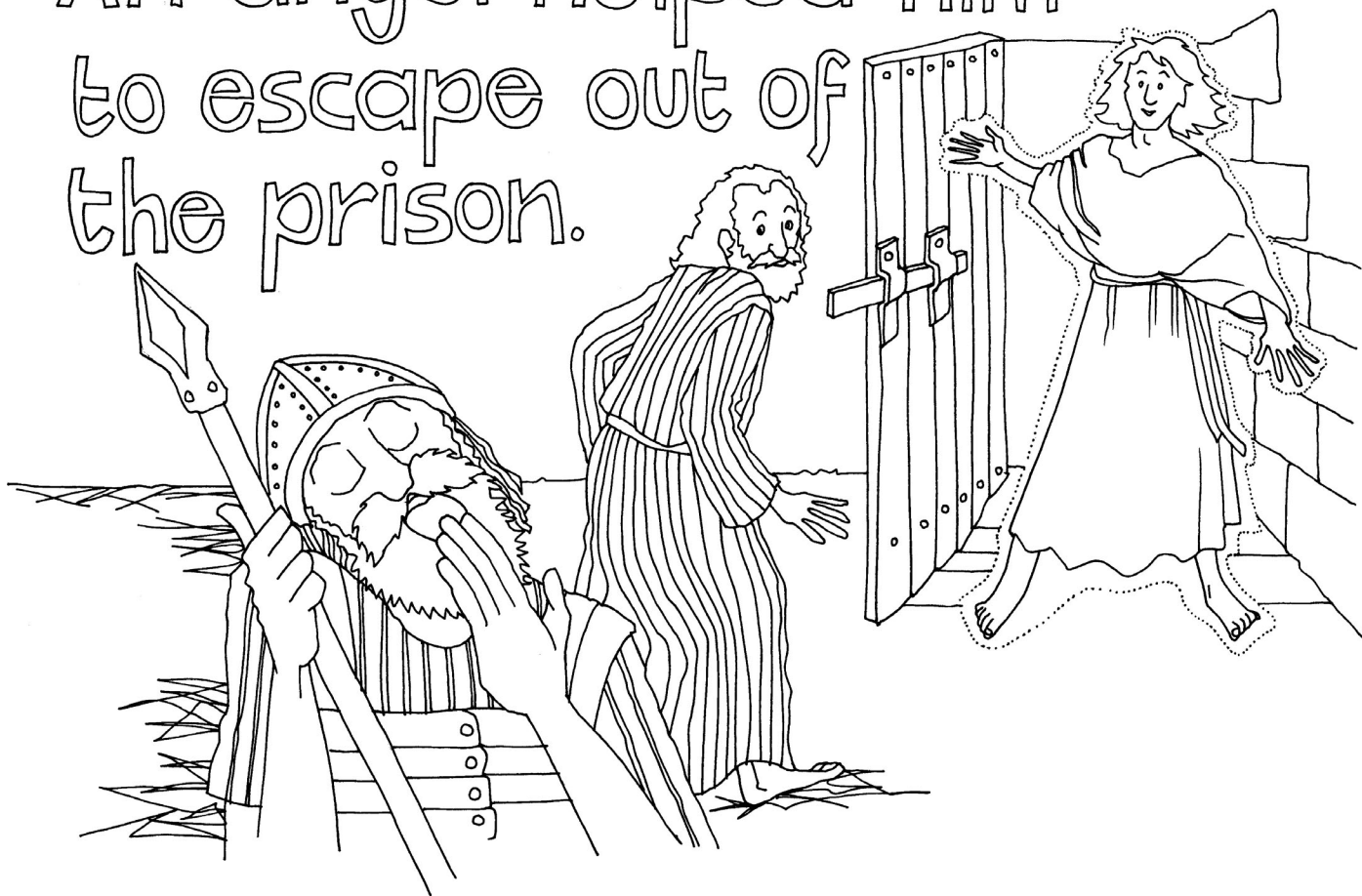




Peter was thrown
