

On the road to Jerusalem, Jesus stopped at the Mount of Olives overlooking the city.

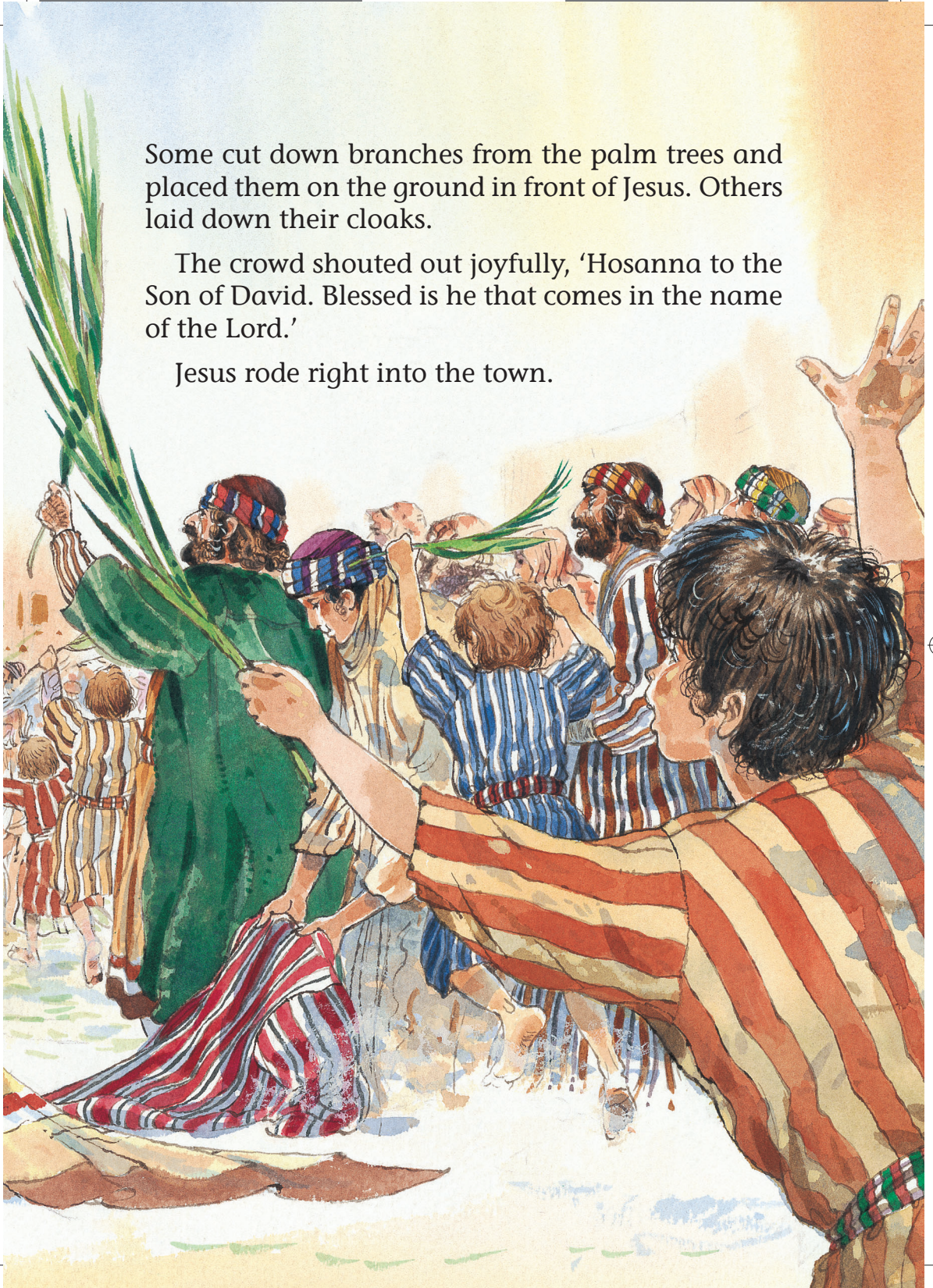
‘Go to that village over there,’ he told two of his disciples. ‘You will find a young donkey. Bring it to me.’
