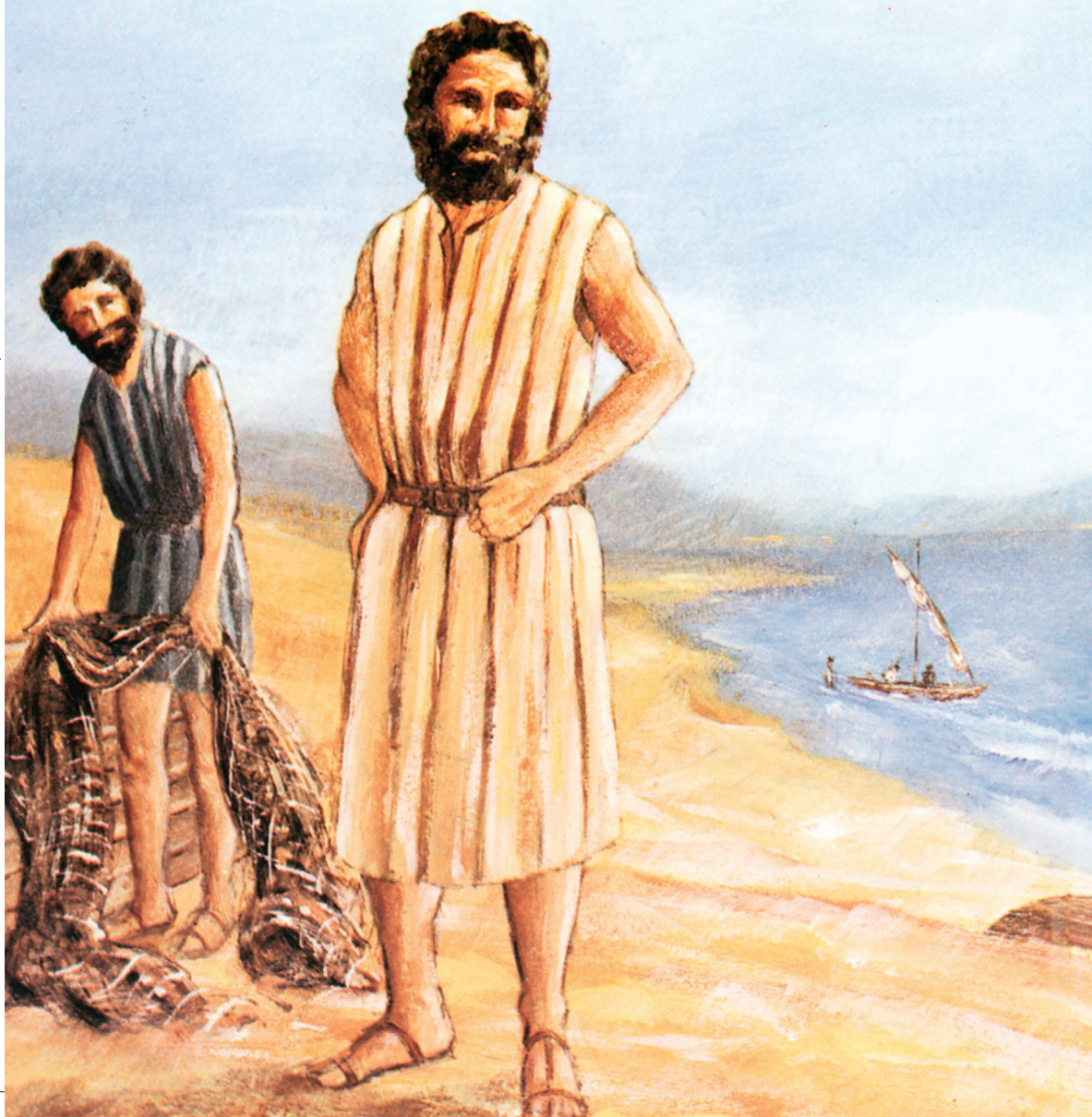


Long ago, in the town of Capernaum by the Lake of Galilee, lived a man called Simon and his family. Simon and his brother, Andrew, were fishermen.
